


We are DASH, Coventry Biennial and Talking Birds. We work in the arts and we support artists.

What is Coventry Biennial



Coventry Biennial is an arts festival. This year it is called HYPER-POSSIBLE. The festival will look at three main things in the city of Coventry

- Art & Language from the 1960's/70's
- The BLK Art Group from the 1980's
- Cybernetic Culture Research Unit from the 1990's/2000's



The art will look at different ideas to do with

- Housing
- Climate change and the environment



- Education
- New ideas for the future like Cyber-Feminism and Afro-Futurism.

We want artists who can make work that fits with one of these ideas, if you can.



We are sorry but students cannot apply for the residency.

What does the artist get



The artist we choose will get time, space and the chance to talk to other artists. We call this a **residency**.

A residency gives you the chance to

- o Think
- Experiment and try out new ideas
- o Take a chance on something different.



What is the artist fee

You will get a residency fee of £1,500



We will also pay for any support you need.

The fee for your artwork is £1,000
