Your Worlds Within Worlds Proposal

- Text Format: Keep your proposal under 500 words and send as a Word doc.
- Audio Format: Keep your audio proposal under 5 minutes in length and send it to us as an MPEG-3 file or a link (eg. Youtube)
- Movie Format: Keep your film proposal under 5 minutes in length and send as an MPEG-4 file or a link (eg. Youtube) note: we do not expect professional film quality

Please Include in Your Proposal

- A summary of your Worlds Within Worlds project idea
- An idea of the medium and materials you will be using
- A description of the creative process (eg. the skills and/or techniques involved)
- The outcome(s) you imagine might result from the 3 workshops

• You can also include up to 5 images/videos/links to help illustrate your ideas

Please Remember

- Each student must have creative agency and/or input into their work
- You can ask the students to continue with your project in their own time, so long as this s an achievable task
- Workshops should be inclusive and adaptable for all learner types DASH will support you in planning your workshop as needed.

Examples of Your Work

To demonstrate that you will be able to deliver the vision outlined in your proposal (and with the appropriate support and materials included) you should send us:

- Up to 5 examples of your work that relates to your proposal (eg. Similar material/medium or theme/project)
- You can include work that has been co-produced or co-facilitated
- You can also send videos (up to 5 minutes long) and links

Materials Budget

- DASH has budgeted £500 for each project proposal this is to cover 3 workshops with a group of up to 8 students.
- For specialists, such as a filmmakers, performance artists or animators, you may use the budget to cover additional time to produce your world within worlds.
- Do not worry about including a budget with your proposal however, please be sure that the materials you suggest in your pitch are within our budget.
